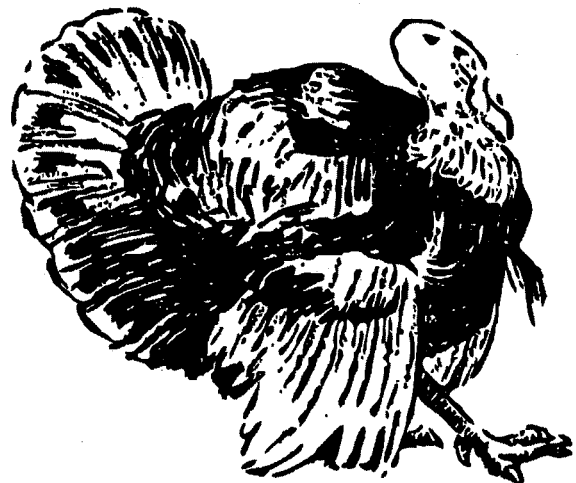

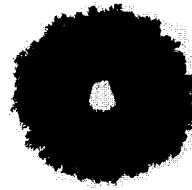

In addition to the collection program at the center, you and your family members may return bottles and cans to McBride's Bottle and Can Return, 80 Smokey Hollow Rd.

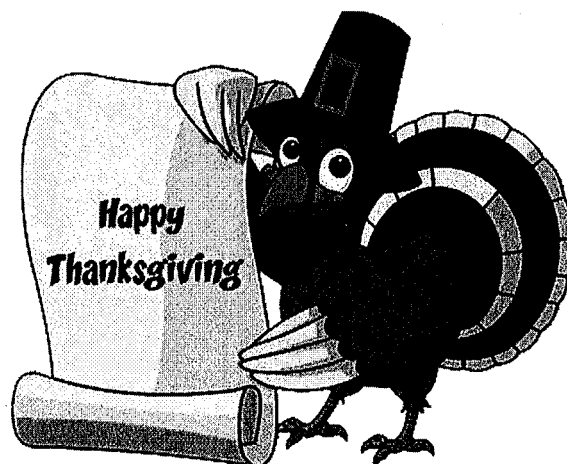
